There will be various stalls including home-baking, crafts and books as well as Leprosy Mission products for sale.

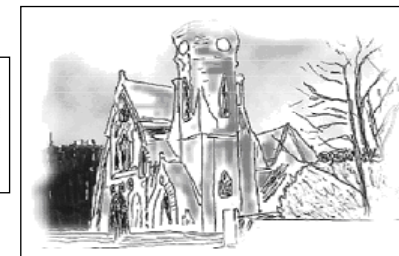
